5. Rich cut **two** strips of **blue** paper.
6. Brad and Trish **want to** stop at **the** Crab Shack.

CCPS standard for reading fluency is 98% accuracy. All heart words are in bold and cannot be sounded out, they must be known by heart. The other words can be sounded out using our stretch and say strategy. This assessment is untimed. Scoring for 50 words:

CCPS scoring guide for accuracy:

Advanced (20 points)- 98% accuracy;

Proficient (15 points)- 95%-97% accuracy;

Basic (10 points)- Below 95% accuracy
