THIS WEEK IN FIRST GRADE

Phonics: This week we will focus on reading and spelling words with digraph blends, digraphs and blends. Consonant blends are different from digraphs because in a blend, each letter spells one sound. In a diagraph, two letters spell one sound. Some examples are: blush, branch, and squish. Our sight words for this week are people, through, and thought. We will test this friday, february 28th.

reader's workshop: We will read the story <u>Chester the Brave</u>. We will compare and contrast the character's adventures in this book. Since Chester is a raccoon, we will research real raccoons using Pebblego.com.

Writer's Workshop: We will continue with our Personal Narrative unit. Our amazing authors will publish their small moments.

Math: We will continue working with the doubles addition strategy (6+6, 7+7, 5+5, etc.) and the doubles subtraction strategy (12-6, 14-7, 10-5, etc.). Don't forget a list of these strategies can be found in section 3 of the binder
