Directions: Read left to right. All vowel sounds are short. Students may "stretch and say" to sound out these words. Below the line read the high frequency words left to right; the goal is to read each word within 3 seconds.

Practice reading the sentences fluently and accurately.

1. Sam will call **the** dog **for** a snack with **his** bell.
2. Can **you** play chess with **Dr. Shisler**?
3. Will **you** still **come to the** mall with us?
4. **Our** chick pecks in **the green** grass **by the old** well.
5. **I** got a sniff **of** that stuff and, boy, did it smell !

CCPS standard for reading fluency is 95% -97% accuracy. All heart words are in bold and cannot be sounded out, they must be known by heart. The other words can be sounded out using our stretch and say strategy. This assessment is untimed. Scoring for 50 words:

%	Below 94%	94%	96%	98%	100%
errors	4 or more	3	2	1	0

CCPS scoring guide for accuracy:

Advanced (20 points)- 98% accuracy;

Proficient (15 points)- 95%-97% accuracy;

Basic (10 points)- Below 95% accuracy
