## This Week in First Grade May 13-17

**Phonics:** Our focus this week will be to read and spell long e words spelled with the pattern ea and ee. There is no spelling rule for ee and ea. Therefore, we will only practice reading the words. Some examples include: feet, leak, speech, beach. Our sight words are **enough**, **great**, **school** and **away**. **There will NOT be a test this week**.

Reader's Workshop: Our students will read <u>Just a Dream</u>, focusing on various settings and how pollution destroys each one.

Writer's Workshop: We will wrap up our All About unit. Our little author's will publish their All About's and share with the class!

Math: Our mathematicians will continue to work on place value. They will use manipulatives, pictures and strategies to help them solve problems within 100, as well as mentally subtract and add 10 to a given number.

**Science:** We will continue with our insects unit. We will discover how different mouths of insects help them to eat.
