

THIS WEEK IN FIRST GRADE

SEPTEMBER 9-13

Phonics: This week we are continuing to focus on letters, letter sounds, rhyming and Kindergarten High Frequency Words.

Reader's Workshop: We are learning to become a community of learners. We are exploring what Readers Workshop looks like. We will read My Brave Year of Firsts. Using this book, we will focus on the characters, setting, sequence of events and the central message.

Writer's Workshop: We will be discussing what Writer's Workshop looks like and how it sounds. We are introducing the routines and the expectations. We will be making a list of reasons people write (email, grocery lists, greeting cards, etc).

Math: Our mathematicians are busy collecting, organizing, displaying and interpreting data to understand information. So far we have collected data on the following: How do you get home? Do you have a pet? How were you feeling the first day of school?

Social Studies: We will continue to discuss school rules and the importance of following them. To honor those who lost their lives on 9/11, we will talk about heroes. The kids will write about their hero. ☺
