

THIS WEEK IN FIRST GRADE

SEPTEMBER 23-26

Phonics: This week we are spelling short i and short u words. Some examples include sit, nip, pup, and jug. Our sight words for this week are *one, two* and *were*. We **WILL NOT** have a test this week. We will test short i words and short u words next Friday, October 4th.

Reader's Workshop: We are learning to become a community of learners. We will continue to introduce centers. Students will continue to practice reading a book that is appropriate for them and retell it to their partner. We will discuss real reading vs. fake reading.

Writer's Workshop: We are still discussing pre-writing and recording writing ideas in our writer's notebooks. Our authors will begin to illustrate and write sentences. We will discuss what they are to do when they get stuck spelling a word, as well as how to use the various resources in the room to help them while writing.

Math: We are wrapping up our Place Value unit. Our mathematicians will continue to work on counting and writing numbers to 120. We will also look at patterns in a 120's chart and figure out missing numbers in a number line and 120's chart. We are slowly introducing math centers.

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Social Studies/Science: In Social Studies, we are still discussing how to be a good citizen and following rules. We will begin our Insects unit. We will discuss the important of bugs.
