

This Week in First Grade

SEPTEMBER 30–OCTOBER 4

Phonics: This week we are continuing to spell short i and short u words. Some examples include sit, nip, pup, and jug. Our sight words for this week are *one*, *two* and *were*. We will test on Friday, October 4th.

Reader's Workshop: We are learning to become a community of learners. We will continue to introduce centers. We will classify text as literature and informational.

Writer's Workshop: Our authors will begin to illustrate and write sentences. We will discuss what they are to do when they get stuck spelling a word, as well as how to use the various resources in the room to help them while writing.

Math: Our mathematicians will continue to work on counting and writing numbers to 120. We will shift our focus to adding and subtracting numbers within 20. We will begin by retelling various story problems and acting them out. Our mathematicians will use drawings, counters (manipulatives) and various organizers to solve these story problems.

Social Studies/Science: We will discuss the importance of bugs. We will focus on various body parts of living organisms and discuss how they help them survive.
