THIS WEEK IN FIRST GRADE

April 29-May 3

Phonics: Our focus this week will be to read and spell words with long a spelled with an **ay** and **ai**. Long a is usually spelled with the -ai team in the middle of the baseword. The -ay team is at the end of a baseword. Some examples include: braid, drain, spray, tray. Our sight words are food, laugh and together. WE will TEST This FRIday, May 3Rd.

Reader's Workshop: We will finish up with <u>The Wump World</u>. Using this story, we will discuss the major events and central message. We will also compare and contrast the adventures and experiences of the characters in <u>The Lorax</u> and <u>The Wump World</u>.

Writer's Workshop: We will continue with our All About writing unit. The students will use their web to create sentences about their topic. They will also work on adding headings, illustrations, captions and a Table to Contents to their writing.

Math: Our mathematicians will use a variety of math strategies to solve addition and subtraction word problems. We will use a variety of graphic organizers and manipulatives. We will assess this week.

Science: Our scientists will continue with our Insect unit. We will discuss how people and animals have body parts, as well as our 5 senses to help us survive. This will lead up to discovering that insects have various body parts to help them survive as well.
