

THIS WEEK IN FIRST
GRADE

May 6-10

Phonics: Our focus this week will be to read and spell words with the consonant -le syllable. The consonant -le is always found at the end of a word. Some examples include: bundle, marble, and snuffle. Our sight words are guess, goes and says. **WE will TEST THIS FRIDAY, MAY 10TH. THIS will be OUR LAST SPELLING TEST FOR THE YEAR! Yay! ☺**

Reader's Workshop: We will also introduce the book The Great Kapok Tree. Using this book, our readers will use the illustrations and details to describe the various characters in the book.

Writer's Workshop: We will continue with our All About writing unit. They will work on adding headings, illustrations, captions and a Table of Contents to their writing. We will also begin editing and revising.

Math: We will begin Module 8 which revisits place value. The students will use various tools such as 120's chart the open number line and place value blocks to count 1 more, 1 less, 10 more and 10 less.

Science: Our scientists will continue with our Insect unit. We will discuss and record the various body parts that organisms have in order to help them survive. We will also observe plastic bugs and identify their body parts that they have in order to survive.
